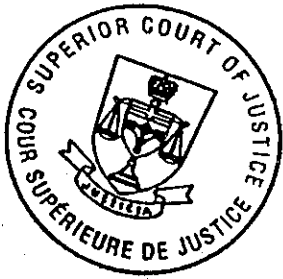

BANKRUPTCY ORDER

UPON READING the Application for Bankruptcy Order of LaSalle Business Credit, a division of ABN AMRO Bank N.V., Canada Branch (the "Applicant"), having an office at 79 Wellington Street West, 15th Floor, in the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, a creditor, the Affidavit of Verification of David Carson, the Affidavit of David Carson sworn April 4, 2007, the Affidavits of Service upon Genfast Manufacturing Company and the Superintendent of Bankruptcy, and upon hearing the submissions from counsel for the Applicant and Genfast Manufacturing Company and, those of other parties in attendance;

AND UPON it appearing to the Court that the following act of bankruptcy has been committed:

- (a) that Genfast Manufacturing Company, has at some time during the six months preceding the date of the filing of the Application for Bankruptcy Order has ceased to meet its liabilities generally as they become due in that it has failed to pay its indebtedness to the Applicant and to other creditors;

1. THIS COURT ORDERS that the time for service of this Application is hereby abridged so that this Application is properly returnable today and hereby dispenses with further service thereof.

2. THIS COURT ORDERS that Genfast Manufacturing Company of the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, be and it is hereby adjudged bankrupt and a Bankruptcy Order is hereby made against Genfast Manufacturing Company effective as at 3:00 p.m. (Toronto time) on April 5, 2007.

3. THIS COURT ORDERS that KPMG Inc. of the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, be and it is hereby appointed Trustee of the Estate of the said bankrupt effective as at 3:00 p.m. (Toronto time) on April 5, 2007.

4. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Trustee give security in an amount to be fixed by the Official Receiver pursuant to section 16(1) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*.

5. THIS COURT ORDERS that the costs of and incidental to this Application and Bankruptcy Order be paid to the Applicant out of the assets of the estate upon taxation thereof.
