Local Scholarship Program

Value and Duration

The Cayman firm will provide financial assistance, per standard tuition costs, to attend the University College of the Cayman Islands, Associate of Accounting two year program. Sponsorship will include student fees, books and supplies as requisite. All payments are made directly to the College at the beginning of each term.

Qualifications

- Applicants must be Caymanian or hold Caymanian Status.
- Applicants should be between the ages of 16 - 25 years and must have the necessary background to achieve success at a competitive university.
- Applicants should have received notice of acceptance from UCIC.
- Applicants must possess a High School Diploma.
- Applicants must have at least 5 IGCSE/GCSE/CXE passes with a grade C, 3, or higher.
- Applicants should provide their SAT results for math and critical reading scores of 900 minimal or ACT score of 19.

Overseas Scholarship Program

Value and Duration

The Cayman firm will provide financial assistance of up to US\$30,000 per year, up to a maximum of 4.5 years. This is intended to be used toward standard tuition, student fees, books and supplies, and room and board as requisite.

Qualifications

- Applicants must be Caymanian or hold Caymanian Status.
- Applicants should be at least 17 years of age and must have the necessary background to achieve success at a competitive university.
- Applicants should have received notice of acceptance by an approved educational institution overseas.
- Applicants must possess a High School Diploma and have at least 5 IGCSE/GCSE/CXE passes with a grade B, 2, or higher or equivalent passes in home country dictated by their governing Board of Education or Ministry and/or hold an Associate Degree with a GPA of 3.0 or higher from a regionally accredited university or community college.
- Applicants should provide their SAT results for math and critical reading scores of 900 minimal or ACT score of 19.

Selection Process

- Applications are considered on an annual basis.
- Applicants will be required to undergo an aptitude test administered by the Cayman firm.
- Applicants will be required to attend an interview with the Human Resource Manager and a Partner of the Cayman firm. Interviews are usually conducted between April and May.
